

Iv SAN BERNARD^{USA} **Labrador Retriever Bathing Instructions**

Labrador Retrievers are a short to medium coated breed. If your Lab has a smooth coat that lays tight to the body with minimal undercoat, then it will be considered a short coat. If your Lab has a thicker coat with more profuse undercoat, then it will be considered a medium coat.

For best results, follow the Iv San Bernard bathing instructions sheet. Products should be diluted 1 part product to 3 parts water and allowed to sit on the dog for a full 5 mins before rinsing.
